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**SEVERE WEATHER INFORMATION NUMBER TEN (10) – DEVELOPING TROPICAL  
DISTURBANCE WITHIN THE REGION  
ISSUED BY THE SAMOA METEOROLOGY DIVISION AT 5:00PM  
TUESDAY 18<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2020**

- ...WIND WARNING FOR ALL OF SAMOA...**
- ... HEAVY RAIN WARNING FOR SAMOA...**

A broad area of low pressure system with associated active convergence zone continue to impact Samoa but gale force winds are now shifted to the Northeast as the result of Tropical Disturbance 08F movements. Tropical Disturbance 08F will maintain its southeast movement away from the islands and is less likely to bring any impacts.

Tropical Disturbance 07F remains as a weak system to the southeast of Tuvalu and has a low to moderate potential to develop into a Tropical Cyclone within the next 24hours. The system is expected to move southeast.

However, the associated active convergence zone is most likely to bring strong gusty winds, torrential rain at times and damaging heavy swells by tonight towards tomorrow.

**Potential Impacts:**

Heavy downpours with poor visibility, strong and gusty winds with flying objects, foggy and slippery roads over mountain passes and ranges, strong river outflow and landslides, pooling near roadsides and waterways. Strong currents as well as rough seas and coastal inundation. Uproot breakable trees.
