Peitai, o peau māmā i Matū i Sisifo o Savai'i o lo'o fa'amoemoe e aga'i mai foi i saute i sasa'e. O timuga mamafa fa'apea matagi to'fa'ata'uta'u malolosi o lo'o feso'ota'i atu i nei peau māmā ole Ea e ono a'afia ai le Atunu'u ile po nei agai ile aso ā taeao. O le sami e matua sousou faapea galu fafati ole a fa'atupulaia le maualuluga. O nei uiga louloua ole Tau e ono fa'aiti'itia agai atu ile fa'aiuga ole vайaso.

MONDAY 17th FEBRUARY 2020

A broad area of low pressure system with an extensive cloud band and gale winds is now located over Samoa. As of 2:00pm this afternoon, there are two developing low pressure systems along this area of active convective near the island to the Northwest of Savai'i and the other to southeast of Tutuila whereas Tropical disturbance 07F (07F) remains near Tuvalu.

Currently the most active system is situated to the southeast. This system is expected to maintain its southeast movement within the next 24hours with slight development. The low pressure system to the Northwest of Savai'i may follow the similar path. But, the associated active convergence links to both system is most likely to bring damaging gusty winds, torrential rain and damaging heavy swells this evening towards tomorrow.

Tropical disturbance 07F remains as a weak low-level circulation and has a low potential to develop into a Tropical cyclone within the next 24-48hours.

Potential Impacts:

Heavy downpours with poor visibility, strong and gusty winds with flying objects, foggy and slippery roads over mountain passes and ranges, strong river outflow and landslides, pooling near roadsides and waterways. Strong currents as well as rough seas and coastal inundation. Uproot breakable trees.
