Traveller Medical Assessment Requirement

ALL Travellers Originating **From or Transiting** Through the countries and States as referred to in the travel advise are required to **undergo medical examination** by a Registered Medical Practitioner **within (3) days before ARRIVAL**. This medical clearance is required for check-in prior to issuing of boarding passes.

Letter/Certificate must have the Clinic/Service provider letter head with contact details, address (physical and email address) and the provider/registration number, doctor's signature and full name and stamp (if available) is to be presented on arrival to health officers at port of entry.

Medical check entails:

- General medical consultation/assessment for fitness to travel and you are not currently sick.
- Any laboratory investigation is the discretion of your medical doctor based on assessment and travel
 history within the past 14 days prior to travel to Samoa as testing for corona virus 2019 (2019-nCoV)
 is not readily available in all countries.
- Test for Corona Viruses is now a requirement for travellers from:
 - 1. China;

4. <u>Japan;</u>

2. Hong Kong;

5. Singapore;

3. Macau;

6. Thailand

The medical report must be within 3 days before arrival; meaning the medical report/certificate should not be more than 3 days old.

The health declaration form is filled inflight or on arrival in Samoa.
