**SEPTEMBER 2020 Fuel Prices**

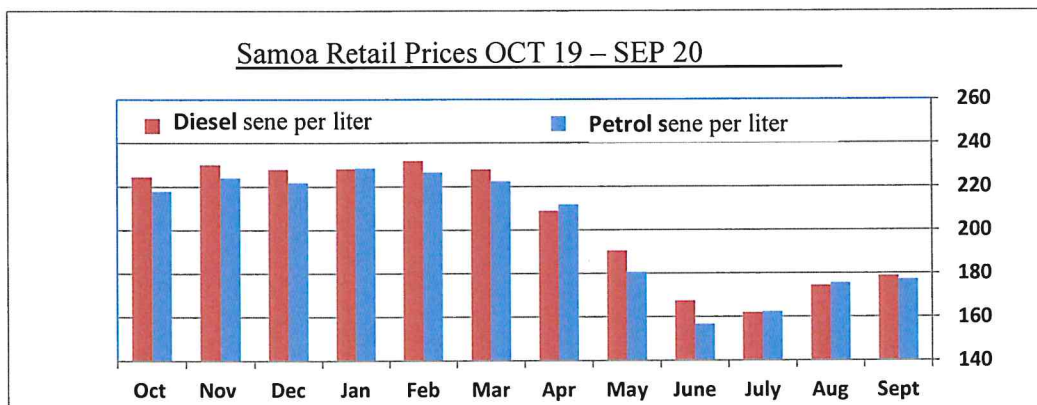
The Minister of Finance, Sili Epa Tuioti has advised that the following changes in retail petroleum products prices will apply from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020

The Minister announced an increase in the Retail Price for Petrol by 2.0 sene from \$2.13 to \$2.15 sene per litre, Diesel by 5.2 sene from \$2.12 sene to \$2.17 per litre, and Kerosene by 3.1 sene from \$1.67 to \$1.70 per litre.

Crude and product prices are relatively stable as the impact of the Covid-19 Pandemic slows the world's economies. Production cuts by OPEC+ have been effective albeit there remains doubt on whether the agreement will hold.
