2022 Fuel Prices

The Minister of Finance has advised that the following changes in retail petroleum products prices will apply from 1st February 2022

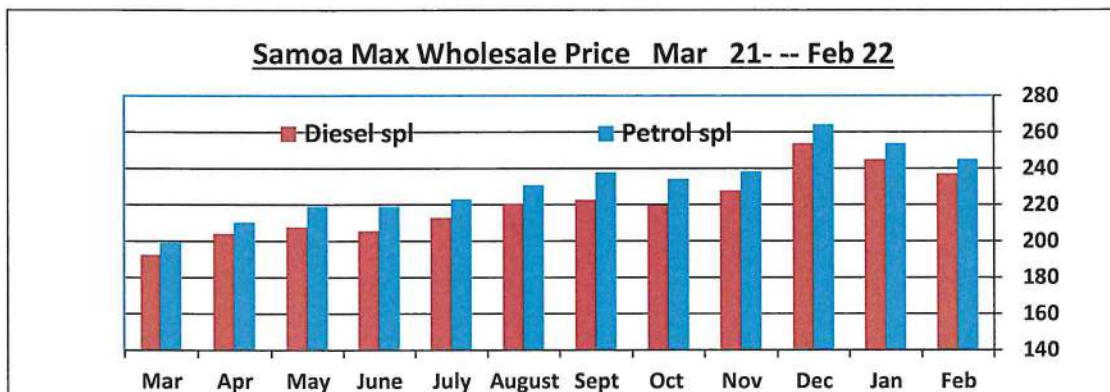
The Minister announced the following decreases in the Retail Prices for Petrol by 10.01 sene from \$3.03 to \$2.93 sene per litre. Diesel will decrease by 9.12 sene from \$2.93 to \$2.84 sene per litre and for Kerosene will decrease by 7.67 sene from \$2.54 to \$2.46 sene per litre.

The marker prices for February 2022 are based on December MOPS International Product Prices which decreased by US\$ 6.00 /bbl. Freight Rates were stable however the US\$ strengthened against the TALA by 1.6%

Ongoing concerns regarding the impact of the COVID 19 pandemic on the world economy continue to impact the market for crude oil and refined products.
