**ADDRESS BY THE HONOURABLE PRIME MINISTER – FIAME NAOMI MATAAFA
-COMMEMORATION OF 60 YEARS OF INDEPENDENCE - Monday, 23rd May 2022**

Good afternoon Samoa.

As we approach our 60th Independence anniversary celebrations on the 1st of June, our programme has been designed to promote the spirit of participation and inclusiveness. Our journey over these many years is a testament of our unity as a nation, our faith in the Lord, and perseverance in trials and tribulations. We would not have made it this far, if we had not steered together, through the divine guidance of our God.

We believe that centring our celebration for independence in communities truly reflects our journey over these 60 years. It is also a tribute to our forefathers from all districts who led our movement for independence. We remember their offering and sacrifice.

As announced earlier, Cabinet has approved a yearlong celebration of our Independence, from 1st June, 2022 to the 31st of May, 2023. Through this new initiative, we will have a blend of Government hosted, and community led programmes throughout the whole year. A calendar of events has been developed for this yearlong celebrations to be released in the near future. An open invitation has been sent out to communities and organisations that wish to include their programmes and events in this calendar.

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SPECIAL TRAVEL ADVICE FOR TRAVELERS From AMERICAN SAMOA ENTERING SAMOA; MINISTRY OF HEALTH, May 19th 2022



COVID19 Variants affecting our region and the global communities is noted with much concern, hence our Border control efforts is elevated and strictly enhanced.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY;

All Passengers travelling from outside of American Samoa must complete ten (10) days from the date of arrival into American Samoa. Any passenger arriving within the 10 day period will be denied entry and returned back to American Samoa.

Only Samoan Residents/Citizen, essential workers and those approved for medical and visa clearance are allowed to enter Samoa.

THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE ENFORCED AND MUST BE COMPLIED WITH.

ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE IN ENGLISH - ANY OTHER LANGUAGE WILL BE DENIED BOARDING WITHOUT EXCEPTION.

1. All Travelers 5 years and above including flight crew are NOW required to be fully vaccinated with the prescribed 2 doses with the exception of Janssen vaccine before entry into Samoa with any

COVID-19 vaccine and preferably vaccines already pre-qualified by the World Health

Organization (AstraZeneca, Pfizer, Janssen-single dose, Moderna, Sinopharm, etc,etc).

2. A legitimate vaccine certificate is required for boarding. Being fully vaccinated implies completion of the required prescribed doses as per vaccine used. All should have completed 2 weeks (14 days) post vaccination prior to travel. The vaccine certificate must be a Health Authority Approved Certificate/Card of country where vaccination took place and should contain at least the

following information:

a. Name of Country
b. Name of person - should be the same as name on passport or birth certificate

c. National Identification/Registration Number if available
d. Address of Clinic and contact details
e. Name of Vaccine and Batch Number

f. Dates of Vaccination (must show dates of vaccination including dates of booster doses)

g. Name of Vaccinator (optional)
h. Health Institution Stamp if available

3. A hard copy of vaccine certificate must be presented at check in and on arrival into Samoa for

sighting and also during registration at quarantine/isolation facilities.

4. Encourage all eligible passengers to have a booster dose done prior to travel.

5. Medical Clearance signed by attending physician within 48 hours

before departure. The medical clearance report must be presented in hard copy on arrival.

6. COVID-19 RAT tests report within 48 hours before departure. The COVID-19 report RAT must be presented in hard copy on arrival

7. All passengers are responsible for their own transport and self/home isolation arrangements

On Arrival into Samoa

a. All passengers are required to wear face mask at all times.

b. All passengers on arrival must submit to a Nasal pharyngeal Swab for PCR testing.

c. All passengers or guardian must sign a consent for self/home isolation

d. All passengers must self/home isolate for 7 days

e. All passengers must provide a valid local phone number and email/facebook address.

f. All passengers are required to arrange and have a medical supervised Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) done at any health facility or private clinic on day 3 and day 7 of self/home isolation and report results to the Ministry of Health.

g. Self-Testing at home is NOT acceptable.

h. Any passenger with a POSITIVE test must self/home isolate for 10 days from the date tested positive with a repeat test done on day 10.

i. All close contacts of a positive case must also self/home isolate for 7 days with RAT test done on day 7.

j. All Positive RAT tests require a nasopharyngeal swab to be done for PCR and Genomic testing.

k. Failure to provide required information and adherence to self/home isolation requirement will result in a fine of \$2,000.00 Samoan Tala or higher or to the extent of your name being publicized.

Your compliance with the conditions listed is imperative to ensuring the safety of all travelers and our people in Samoa. We endeavor to keep Samoa COVID-19 Free.

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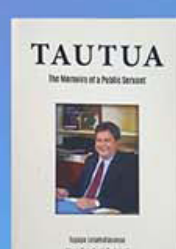

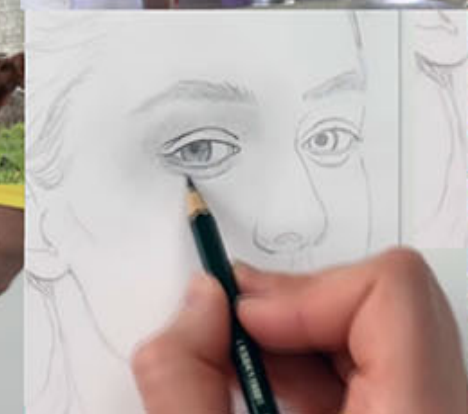

Situational Report On Covid-19 Pandemic

(PRESS RELEASE, 15th - 18th May 2022) - The Ministry of Health’s latest report confirmed 331 new COVID-19 cases from 2.00pm of May 15th to 2pm of May 18th. 325 confirmed community cases and 6 new cases detected at the border. This takes the total number of positive cases (both community and border cases) in Samoa to 12,382. There are seven (7) patients currently in managed isolation at Moto’otua Hospital.

COVID-19 RELATED DEATHS

Sadly, one (1) new COVID-19 related death was identified in this reporting period, taking the total number of deaths to 25. The deceased, a 64 year old male with known comorbidities. He was fully vaccinated, and had also done a booster. Out of respect for the families and relatives, we will not be making any further comments.

Adhering to public health measures such as wearing a mask, maintaining social distance, and washing of hands are important in maintaining good hygiene and in containing the spread of the virus. Vaccination remains our best defense against the virus. Please visit the nearest hospital if you have not done your first or second dose, as well as a booster. Keeping our aiga and loved ones safe is everyone’s responsibility.

In this connection, I am pleased to announce that the programme for the celebration of our 60th anniversary on the 1st of June will be undertaken in all districts and villages in Samoa. This will be the first time our independence will be celebrated throughout the whole of Samoa. The celebration programming and implementation will be at the discretion and guidance of the respective Council of Chiefs in each district to organise a thanksgiving service in the morning of Wednesday 1st of June. As usual, the 1st of June is a public holiday.

Government will hold the official flag raising ceremony at Tiafau, on 1st June 2022. Due to health restrictions for COVID 19, only a few will be invited to this event. It is our hope that through conducting of celebrations in each district across the country, will provide a golden opportunity for more participation and inclusion of our people, while adhering to health measures to contain the spread of the COVID 19 virus.

Cabinet has approved that all cultural entertainments and other events planned for our 60th independence celebrations will be held in September together with the commemoration of the Teuila Festival.

I would like to use this opportunity to reach out to our Samoan diaspora residing across the world. I am aware that many of you are also planning your Independence celebration in respective countries you live. We acknowledge your contributions and continued support for our country and families in Samoa. On behalf of government and all our people at home, we wish you all the best in your celebrations.

For our celebrations at home, I would again place importance on continuing to observe health measures to help minimize the spread of the virus. The commencement of our celebrations will be signalled by the ringing of church bells and seting off of sirens across the country at 12.00 midnight of Tuesday 31st of May.

The details of our programme will be released by members of the Independence Committee from now on until the 1st of June.

Ambassador of Samoa present Credentials to The King Of Belgium

(PRESS RELEASE - On 18 May 2022 Samoa's new Ambassador to Belgium H.E Ms Francella Strickland presented her credentials to His Majesty King Philippe of Belgium at the Royal Palace of Brussels. This officially confirms her accreditation as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Samoa to the Kingdom and Belgium.

In the conversation following the presentation ceremony, Ambassador Strickland and King Philippe reaffirmed the good relations between the two countries and discussed issues of mutual concern including Covid19, climate change, trade, tourism and education.

The discussion allowed the opportunity for Ambassador Strickland to share with His Majesty the King, Samoa's challenges and priorities particularly as a Small island Developing State. They also discussed coverage of the work of the Embassy and its engagement with the EU and its member states.

Ambassador was accompanied to the credentials presentation ceremony by Ms Fiona Lene-Samoa, Counsellor and Deputy Head of Mission and Ms Rae Manuleleua, First Secretary of the Embassy of Samoa in Brussels.

Ambassador Strickland will also be accredited as Head of Mission to the European Union, other EU countries and the United Kingdom. She has more than 20 years experience in the Samoa foreign service which included postings as First Secretary to the Embassy in Belgium and Counselor and Deputy Head of Mission to the Samoa Mission in New York.

Bee Engaged: Samoa Celebrates World Bee Day 2022

PR - The Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries marks World Bee Day 2022 this week by celebrating the contribution of the bee keeping community, raising awareness about the importance of bees to our agricultural and economic development and educating people on why the protection of bees is vital to our existence. The theme of 2022 is; Bee engaged: Celebrating the diversity of bees and beekeeping systems.

21 June 2022: Since the near decimation of the honey industry in the aftermath of Tropical Cyclone Gita in 2018, the beekeeping community have slowly recovered over the last five years with honey products once again appearing on store shelves in the country.

Despite the slow recovery, a founding member of the first Beekeeping Association of Samoa in 1976, Raymond Voigt of Pesega says it is encouraging to see a revitalised interest in the honey bee industry with more farming organisations looking to work together to lift the number of hives in Samoa.

“We started the Beekeeping Association of Samoa back in 1976,” said Mr Voigt. “We reached about 50 members but eventually people lost interest because they realised it’s not a quick money scheme and didn’t want to take a “hands on” approach to caring for the bees. The whole thing dwindled and now there’s just a core group of people who are interested in carrying it on so we discontinued as an incorporated society and continued as a community based group”

“We have been granted funding through Civil Society Support Programme - Green Climate Change Fund. We now hear they want us to incorporate as a society so we’ll try that route again and see how it goes. There are various organisations that are interested in bees such as the Samoa Farmers Association, Samoa Federated Farmers Incorporated and Samoa Womens’ Association of Growers. It’s encouraging to see a renewed collective interest and we would like to see people take a more hands on approach. “

The CSSP funding will enable the building of an extraction facility in Magiagi village for those interested in harvesting their own honey. With only just over 400 beehives in Samoa,

Mr Voigt says this will encourage growth in the industry, attract more people to take up beekeeping, address the honey shortage in Samoa and ultimately move the beekeepers industry closer to their long term vision of exporting.

“ We are finalising the process of building an extraction facility in Magiagi which means beekeepers can go in and harvest, extract, put back their frames and sell their honey” he said. “There’s a shortage of honey because of the small amount of beehives so we need to take that number up to 1500 hives. Then we can realise a larger harvest of honey like back in the 1980s when Samoa German Bee Company was operating. They had 1500 beehives and exported honey to Europe.”

“We are looking long term at exporting because right now the market in Samoa is four tonnes and its growing - we can’t keep up. We’ve experienced a good harvest from Savaii. This is why we are increasing hives there because of the large forest, vast amount of blossoming plants and uninhabited areas.”

With Samoa celebrating World Bee Day for the first time this year, another early founding member of the Samoa Beekeepers Association, Lester Dean of Saleimoa, says he had never heard of an international Day for Bees before but feels encouraged seeing more awareness in the media about the plight of the bees and their invaluable impact on the environment.

Mr Dean and members of beekeeping community want to remind us that bees are not just a good source of natural food. Bees also play a critical role as pollinators in our agriculture sector by increasing crop yields and promoting food security. Without bees, various flowers and vegetable crop numbers would decline.

“The fact is the more bees pollinate your fruit and vegetable crops, the higher your yields and size of fruit” said Mr Dean. “Without the bees there would be a lot less food to eat and it’s the same throughout the world. If bees became extinct, there will eventually be no life on earth.”

Organic farmer and beekeeper, Mele Mauala says there are multiple ways Samoans can get on board with protecting bees and keeping them off the extinction list,

“Let’s preserve our wild bees, don’t kill them!” says Ms Mauala. “There are potentially 20 different species in Samoa who contribute to pollination of native species and agricultural crops. Pesticides and herbicides are deadly to bees and other pollinators. They are also not good for humans. We should all try different ways to protect our crops, animals and our communities.”

Feebee Honey producer, Sione Alailima of Vaoala, has been a beekeeper since 2017 and says the visible impact of bees to his surroundings cannot be understated. He started beekeeping as a way to earn extra income to support family and village commitments after relocating permanently from the USA to Samoa in 2017.

“Without bees we would basically starve” said Mr Alailima. “Which is why, we are very adamant in maintaining as much of the natural environment as we can because this is where our bees forage and feed from. If we don’t maintain it then the bees would have nothing and in the end we will have nothing.”

Mr Alailima keeps his bees in two locations in Siusega and Vaoala on family properties. He currently has a total of 15 beehives and plans to increase to 25 beehives by the end of the year. His goal is to reach 40 hives and hopes the government will support the industry in creating pathways to export markets.

Although beekeeping requires a lot of work especially in the beginning, Mr Alailima says it can be rewarding if you’re prepared to put in the hard work,

“To become a beekeeper and honey producer, it’s important to understand that it’s not a quick money operation“ he said. “You have to have patience and diligence but the reward is there at the end when you see your harvest from the bees. It’s hard to describe the feeling except you feel very happy because you see the fruits of your labour and you’re doing a lot good for the environment too.”

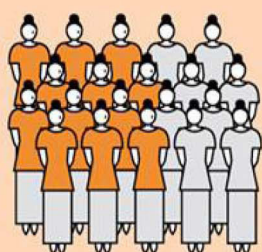
