



EMERGENCY ORDER 80

CONSTITUTION OF THE INDEPENDENT STATE OF SAMOA 1960 (ARTICLES 105/106)

I, TUIMALEALI'IFANO VA'ALETOA SUALAUVI II, Head of State of the Independent State of Samoa, in consultation with Cabinet under **FK (22) Faapitoa 26**, and pursuant to **Article 106** of the Constitution, make the following **ORDERS**:

1. Public Health Advisory

For all public places to encourage the following conditions:

- (a) Observe social distancing;
- (b) must wear face masks; and
- (c) must comply with the measures for the prevention of the spread of COVID-19 as advised by the Ministry of Health and National Emergency Operation Centre from time to time.

2. International travel by plane, boat or ship:

- (1) All international travel to and from Samoa by plane or boat or ship is permitted for Samoan citizens only or other passengers as provided in special circumstances approved by Cabinet.
- (2) Cargo flights to and from Samoa are permitted to bring in or take cargo goods every week.
- (3) Airforce flights to Samoa are permitted as approved by Cabinet for:
 - (a) the carriage of firearms and ammunition; or
 - (b) the transporting of any assistance for emergency; or

(c) any other purpose in exceptional circumstances.

(4) All boats and ships and yachts are prohibited access except for:

(a) trade and petroleum;

(b) fishing boats approved for offloading, refueling, and the restock of necessary supplies only or as approved by Cabinet for exceptional circumstances;

(c) ships approved for uplifting submarine cable supplies from the Samoa Cable Hub;

(d) any other category of ships, boats and yachts for offloading, refueling and the restock of necessary supplies only or as approved by Cabinet for exceptional circumstances;

(e) a boat as approved by Cabinet for travel between Samoa and American Samoa, Tokelau or any other country;

(f) no crew member is to leave the boat unless it is for the purposes of (4)(b) above and provided they meet the medical requirements of the Ministry of Health or as approved by Cabinet.

(5) For fishing boats under (4)(b) above the following apply:

(a) a maximum of 4 boats may dock at Matautu Wharf, for:

(i) purse seiners fishing boats, not more than 120 hours for transshipment, the offloading of fish and restocking of the supplies before leaving Samoa; and

(ii) long liners fishing boats whose cargo are between 100 – 130 tons, not more than 72 hours for the offloading of fish and restocking of the supplies before leaving Samoa; and

(b) medical and quarantine requirements issued by the Director General of the Ministry of Health are to be complied with; and

(c) no crew member is to leave the boat unless it is for the purposes of (4)(b) above and provided they meet the medical requirements; and

- (d) boat schedules and crew list must be submitted to the Samoa Ports Authority (SPA); Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries (MAF); Ministry of Police and Prisons Services (MOPPS) and the Ministry of Health (MOH); and
 - (e) the date of departure from the last port, or the exchange of any crew members whilst at sea, must not be less than 28 days, before arrival at Matautu wharf; and
 - (f) notification of arrival date must be received by the relevant authorities (MAF and SPA) 5 days prior; and
 - (g) there shall be no exchange of crew members whilst as sea.
- (6) For trade boats and ships allowed under (4) (a) and (c) above, a maximum of 2 trade boats or ships are permitted to be docked at Matautu Wharf at one time and must meet safety requirements set by Samoa Ports Authority and other relevant Government Ministries and Corporations.
- (7) For a boat approved under (4)(e) for **travel between Samoa and Tokelau**, the following conditions apply:
- (a) Travel is permitted except where the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade instructs that travel shall cease or is not permitted;
 - (b) The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade must be informed of intended travel of every person to Samoa, the purpose of travel and the date of intended arrival of every person travelling from Tokelau.
- (8) The Ministry of Health is to continue with the approved medical clearance of all involved under this order.

3. Arriving passengers

- (1) Any passenger, pilot and crew members travelling into Samoa by plane or boat exempted under Order 2(1) and (2) must:
- (a) complete the Medical Clearance Health Documentation Check in Form ;

(b) specifically declare whether or not they have been infected with the COVID19 virus;

(c) must do a COVID19 prescribed by the Ministry of Health.

(2) The Ministry of Health is to continue with the approved medical clearance of all involved under this order.

4. Public gatherings:

Public gatherings and events in most places accessible by the public are permitted.

5. Church worship and gatherings

All church worship and gatherings are permitted.

6. Operating hours for all businesses:

(1) All businesses are permitted to open for their normal business hours.

(2) All businesses open to the public have the responsibility of ensuring public health measures are in place for the protection of all members of the public.

7. Selling of alcohol

(1) The selling of alcohol by any business with any alcohol licence issued under the Alcohol Control Act 2020 is permitted in accordance with the Alcohol Control Act 2020 and conditions allowed under their respective alcohol licences.

(2) For the purpose of this Order some types of alcohol are permitted to be sold except for alcohol prohibited by any Notice issued by the Alcohol Control Board.

8. Schools:

(1) All tertiary education institutions and all schools can commence opening.

(2) The Ministry of Education Sports and Culture must ensure that the

alternative modes of delivery (i.e online learning) are activated for all schools and children to minimize disruption to school operations.

(3) All schools have the responsibility of ensuring public health measures for the protection of staff members and students.

9. Access to Health Facilities:

(1) Unless permitted by the Director General, all persons are prohibited from accessing any hospital unless it is an emergency, or he or she is seeking urgent medical attention or assistance at any health facility on the following conditions:

- (a) observe social distancing;
- (b) must wear face masks.

(2) A person that is admitted to the hospital may:

- (a) only have one carer to tend to him or her; and
- (b) only be visited by 2 people at any one time.

(3) All patients intended for travel overseas under the Samoa Medical Treatment Scheme are hereby suspended unless approved by Cabinet.

10. Ministry of Health duties:

(1) The Ministry of Health shall ensure to implement awareness programmes and measures for the prevention of the spread of the Covid-19.

(2) The Director General of the Ministry of Health is to determine and coordinate a Health Travel Advisory for travelers entering Samoa for the measures for the prevention of the spread of the Covid-19.

(3) The Director General of the Ministry of Health is to determine and coordinate:

- (a) the continuation of vaccination for children;
- (b) the screening and testing of people for COVID19 (Rapid Antigen tests) in hospitals and health facilities, and other areas

determined to conduct tests and vaccinations.

11.Samoa Police Service:

The Samoa Police Service shall enforce this Order.

12.Emergency Order Offence Notice:

- (1) A police officer may serve an Emergency Order Offence Notice (“Notice”) on a person who has committed an offence to which this Emergency applies.
- (2) A Notice under this Order shall be in the form approved by the Commissioner of Police.
- (3) A person who has been served with a Notice must pay the fine stated in the Notice within 24 hours (not including any period in which the country is in lockdown) of the issuance of the Notice.

13.Penalties:

- (1) A person commits an offence where the person does not comply with any of the above orders except for order 2, attracting the following penalties:
 - (a) a fine of:
 - (i) for an individual, a fine of \$200 for a first offence, and a fine of \$500 for a continuous offence; or
 - (ii) for an organization or corporation or similar such legal entity, a fine of \$5,000 for a first offence, and a fine of \$7,000 for a continuous offence; or
 - (b) detainment by the Police not exceeding 3 months; or
 - (c) both detainment and fines prescribed under paragraph (a).
- (2) A person commits an offence where the person does not comply with order 2 and 3 attracting the following penalties:
 - (a) for an individual, a fine of \$2000;
 - (b) for an organization or company, a fine of \$15,000 for a first

offence, and a fine of \$20,000 for a continuous offence.

- (3) A person commits an offence, where the person does not comply with quarantine requirements issued by the Director General of the Ministry of Health attracting a penalty of \$2,000.00.
- (4) The payment of a fine under this Order, shall avoid any further prosecution for the offence stipulated in the Notice issued under Order 12.
- (5) Where a person is convicted of an offence under these Orders, he or she shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$10,000.00 or imprisonment not exceeding 12 months, or both.
- (6) Any business that breaches Order 6 and 7 under these Orders will have their business or alcohol license revoked for the duration of the State of Emergency, in addition to penalties already provided under the relevant legislation regarding business and alcohol licenses.

14. Advisory Board – Article 108:

The Advisory Board appointed under Article 108 of the Constitution, shall not incur any liability for actions done in good faith under Article 108.

15. Flexibility of procedures:

- (1) Given the pandemic Covid19, procedures of Cabinet and Parliament, may be relaxed during the State of Emergency, so that decision making for the good of the country may continue.
- (2) For effective decision making for the country, the above Orders do not bar any urgent and essential meetings of Cabinet or Parliament to take place during the State of Emergency.

16. National Disaster Management Plan:


These Orders form part of the National Management Plan established under

TULAFONO FAAVAE O LE MALO TUTOATASI O SAMOA 1960 (MATAUPU 105/106)

O AU NEL, TUIMALEALI'IFANO VA'ALETOA SUALAUVI II, Ao o le Malo o Samoa, i luga o le fautuaga a le Kapeneta **FK (22) Faapitoa 26**, ma le **Mataupu 106** o le **Tulafono Fa'avae**, ou te faia ai nei **POLOAIGA**:

1. Fautuaga mo le soifua maloloina mo nofoaga faitele

Mo nofoaga faitele e uunaia pea aiaiga nei:

- (a) faamalosia le tutu/nofo vava;
- (e) faamalosia le fai o tali fofoga (face masks) (seia vagana ai taimi e taele ai);
- (i) e tatau ona utagia aiaiga mo le puipuiga o le pipisi o le fa'ama'i o le Korona Vairasi 19 e pei ona fautuaina e le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina po o le National Emergency Operation Centre.

2. Femalagaiga Faavaomalo vaalele ma vaa a lalo:

- (1) E faatagaina femalagaiga faavaomalo ivaalele poo vaa mo tagata sitiseni Samoa poo so'o se pasese e faataga e le Kapeneta i se tulaga tatau ai.
- (2) E faatagaina ona malaga mai i Samoa ma toe foi vaalele mo uta (cargo flights) e aumai ai ma toe ave uta (cargo) ma pasese i vaiaso taitasi.
- (3) E faatagaina ona malaga mai i Samoa vaalele faapitoa Airforce (Airforce flights) pe a faamaonia e le Kapeneta mo:
 - (a) le auina mai o ni uta auupega malolosi;
 - (e) le auina mai o ni fesoasoani i taimi o faalavelave fa'afuase'i matuiā e aafia ai Samoa i se tulaga e tatau ai; po'o
 - (i) ni isi lava mafuaaga e tusa ai ma tulaga e tatau ai.
- (4) Ua tapu le toe ulufale mai o soo se ituaiga vaa seia vagana ai:
 - (a) vaa oloa ma vaa suaau;

- (e) vaa fagota mo le la'u ese o a latou uta (offload) ma le utuina (refuel) ma mo sapalai moomia po o se vaa fagota ua faataga mai e le Kapeneta i se tulaga e tatau ai;
 - (i) vaa ua faatagaina mo le avatu ai cable supplies ma mea faigaluega mo submarine cables mai le nofoaga tutotonu (hub) o loo teu ai nei cable supplies;
 - (o) nisi ituaiga vaa, e aofia ai vaa failā ma nisi, e faamaonia e le Kapeneta mo le utuina (refuel) po o ni isi tulaga e tatau ai;
 - (u) vaa e faatagaina mo le faigamalaga i le va o Samoa, Tokelau ma Amerika Samoa poo ni isi lava atunuu e pei ona faamaonia e le Kapeneta;
 - (f) tapu ona o ese le auvaa mai i le vaa seia vagana mo le faamoemoe i lalo o le 4(e) pe a fai e faamalieina aiaiga faalesoifua maloloina poo ua faamaonia atu e le Kapeneta.
- (5) Mo vaa fagota e faatagaina i lalo o le (4)(e) o aiaiga nei e tatau ona mataituina:
- (a) e nā o le 4 vaa fagota e faataga ona taula i le Uafu i Matautu mo se taimi, ma:
 - (i) mo vaa fagota tetele purse seiners ia lē silia i le 120 itula ona taula mo le la'ueseina o uta i'a, ma toe faatutumu o a latou sapalai ao le'i tuuva'a ese atu ma Samoa; ma
 - (ii) mo vaa fagota long liners e oo atu le mamafa o latou uta i le 100 – 130 tone, ia lē silia i le 72 itula ona taula mo le la'ueseina o uta i'a, ma toe faatutumu o a latou sapalai ao le'i tuuva'a ese atu ma Samoa; ma
 - (e) ia usitaia siaki mo le soifua maloloina (quarantine) e pei ona faatonuina e le Faatonu Sili o le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina; ma
 - (i) tapu ona o ese le auvaa mai i le vaa se'ia vagana mo le faamoemoe i lalo o le 4(e) pe a fai e faamalieina aiaiga faalesoifua maloloina; ma

- (o) faamalosia le tuuina mai o le polokalame o femalagaiga o vaa fagota faatasi ai ma le lisi o auvaa (crew list) e fia ofi mai i le atunuu i le Pulega o Uafu, Matagaluega o Faatoaga ma Faigafaiva, Matagaluega o Leoleo ma Falepuipui, ma le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina; ma
 - (u) ia lē i lalo ifo o le 28 aso talu ona tuua e le vaa fagota le uafu mulimuli sa taula ai, poo se fesuiaiga o le auvaa a o lei taunuu mai i le uafu i Matautu; ma
 - (f) ia faailoa mai le talosaga a soo se vaa fagota i le Pulega o Uafu ma le Matagaluega o Faatoaga ma Faigafaiva e fia ulufale mai i Samoa i totonu o le lima (5) aso ao lei taunuu mai i le uafu i Matautu; ma
 - (g) e tapu le fesui ai o auvaa i ogasami poo nisi galuega faatino i luga o le vaa e aofia ai isi vaa fagota.
- (6) E le tatau ona sili atu ma le lua vaa oloa poo isi vaa e faatagaina i lalo o le (4)(a) ma le (i) ona taula i se taimi e tasi i le Uafu i Matautu ma e tatau ona faamalieina vaega manaomia mo le saogalemu a le Pulega o Uafu ma Taulaga ma isi Matagaluega ma Ofisa a le Malo.
- (7) Mo vaa e faatagaina i lalo o le (4)(u) mo faigamalaga i le va o **Samoa ma Tokelau**, o le a aiaia e faapea:
- (a) le faatagaina o le ulufale mai o tagata Tokelau i Samoa, sei vagana ua logoina e le Matagaluega o le Va-i-Fafo ma Fefaatauaiga le taofia ona ulufale mai;
 - (e) e tatau ona logoina o le Matagaluega o le Va-i-Fafo ma Fefaatauaiga i le mafuaaga ma le aso tonu o le faigamalaga a o le'i malaga mai;
- (8) Ua faatonuina le Matagaluega o le Soifua Maloloina ina ia matua faamalosia puipuiga mo tagata uma i lalo o lenei poloaiga.

3. Pasese malaga mai

- (1) E tatau i se pasese, pailate ma le auvaa e malaga mai i Samoa i se vaalele po o se vaa faatagaina i lalo o le Poloaiga 2(1) ma le (2):
- (a) ona faatumu pepa faamaonia faale- soifua Maloloina e pei ona tuuina atu; ma
 - (e) sainia se tautoga faaletulafono tusitusia (declaration) pe na ia aafia muamua pe leai i le siama o le KOVITI-19;

(i) e tatau ona fai se suega o le KOVITI-19 e pei ona faatonuina mai e le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina.

(2) Ia faaauau siaki faa Soifua Maloloina a le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina.

4. Potopotoga i nofoaga faitele:

Le tatalaina o potopotoga toatele ma nofoaga faitele.

5. Auai atu i Tapuaiga Faalelotu ma Faalapotopotoga Faalelotu

Ua faatagaina le auai atu i tapuaiga faalelotu ma faalapotopotoga faalelotu.

6. Taimi Faatapula'aina mo Pisinisi:

(1) Le tatalaina o pisinisi i tulaga masani:

(2) O pisinisi uma ua tatalaina mo le mamalu o le atunuu e iai le matafaioi o le faamautinoa o tagata uma ia tausisi ina o aiaiga faa soifua maloloina mo le puipuiga o tagata lautele.

7. Faatauina o le Ava Malosi:

(1) Le faatagaina o le fa'atauina atu o le 'ava mālosi e so'o se pisinisi o loo iai se laisene ava malosi e pei ona tu'uina atu i lalo o le Tulafono e Fuafua Tatau ai le Ava Malosi 2020 (Alcohol Control Act 2020) e tusa ai ma aiaiga o loo tuuina mai lalo o le Tulafono e Fuafua Tatau ai le Ava Malosi ma aiaiga o lo'o faatagaina i lalo o latou laisene ava malosi.

(2) I lalo o lenei Poloaga ua faatagaina le faatau atu o nisi ituaiga o 'ava malosi seia vagana ai 'ava malosi ua faasaina e se Faasilasilaga ua tuuina atu e le Komiti Faatino e Fuafuaina Tatau le Ava Malosi (Alcohol Control Board).

8. Aoga:

(1) Le toe amatalia o aoga a le fanau o loo a'otauina i le Iunivesite Aoao o Samoa ma isi aoga.

(2) E tuuina atu i le Matagaluega o Aoga, Taaloga ma Aganuu le tapenaina o isi auala mo a'oa'oga (i.e online learning) ma polokalame mo le faatino ina o a'oa'oga ma faaitiitia ai le aafia o faagasologa o le polokalama.

(3) O aoga uma e iai le matafaioi o le fa'amautinoaina o loo tausisia aiaiga fa'alesoifua maloloina mo le puipuiga o tagata faigaluega ma tamaiti a'oga.

9. Falema'i, ma'i, tausima'i ma siigama'i:

(1) Ua matua tapu ona toe ulufale se tagata i soo se falema'i (hospital) se'iavaganā ai ua moomia ona vaai se foma'i i se faalavelave fa'afuase'i pe ua iai se faatagana mai i le Faatonu Sili o le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloinai lalo o aiaiga nei:

(a) faamalosia le tutu/nofo vava;

(e) faamalosia le fai o tali fofoga (face masks).

(2) Mo le tagata ua taofia:

(a) ua nā o le tasi le tagata tausima'i e faataga; ma

(e) e nā o le toalua (2) tagata e faataga mo asiga.

(3) Ua taofia ona toe auina atu i Niu Sila o gasegase mo togafitiga i lalo o le Polokalame masani a le Malo, se'ia vagana ua faamaonia mai e le Kapeneta.

10. Tiute o le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina:

(1) Ia faatinoina e le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina le unaia o polokalame fa'alauiloa o le puipuiga o le pipisi o le fa'ama'i o le Korona Vairasi 19, mo le nofo silafia o le atunu'u.

(2) E iai le malosiaga a le Pule Sili a le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina e tuuina atu ai fautuaga mo femalagagaiga mo e faimalaga mai fafo ma fautuaga faafemalagaaiga mo faigamalaga faavaomalo mo le puipuiga o le pipisi o le fa'ama'i o le Korona Vairasi 19.

(3) E iai le malosiaga a le Pule Sili a le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina mo:

(a) le faatinoina o tui puipui mo le fanau laiti;

(e) le faatino ina o suega o le Korona Varasi 19 (Rapid Antigen Tests) i falemai, nofoaga ua fuafua e faatino ai ma le faaoga o tafaala e faagaioi ai suega (tests) ma tuiga (vaccination) mo le atunuu.

11. Malosiaga o le Matagaluega o Leoleo:

Ua tuuina atu ile Matagaluega o Leoleo le malosiaga e faamalosia ai le mata'ituina o lenei Poloaga.

12. Pepa faailoa o le Solia o se Poloaga Faalavelave Faafuasei:

(1) E mafai e leoleo ona tuuina atu le Pepa Faailoa o le Solia o se Poloaga i soo se tagata ua solia aiaiga o Poloaga ua faataoto i totonu o Poloaga mo Faalavelave Faafuasei.

(2) O Pepa Faailoa i lalo o lenei poloaga e tataua ona faamaonia e le Komesina o Leoleo.

(3) Soo se tagata ua tuuina atu i ai se Pepa Faailoa o le Solia o se Poloaga, e tataua ona ia totogi le sala tupe ua ta'ua i lea Pepa Faailoa, i totonu o le 24 itula (e le aofia ai piliota o vavao i lalo o lenei poloaga) talu ona tuuina atu iai le Pepa Faailoa.

13. Faasalaga:

(1) E solitulafono le tagata e lē usitaia Poloaga uma ua taua i luga seia vagana ai le poloaga 2, ma o faasalaga nei:

(a) sala tupe:

(i) mo tagata ta'itoatasi, \$200 mo le solitulafono muamua, ma le \$500 i aso ta'itasi e faaauau ai lea solitulafono; ma

(ii) mo faalapotopotoga faatulafono, \$5,000 mo le solitulafono muamua, ma le \$7,000 i aso ta'itasi e faaauau ai lea solitulafono; poo le

(e) taofia i lalo o le vaaiga a Leoleo e lē sili atu i le 3 masina; poo le

- (i) taofia i lalo o le vaaiga a Leoleo ma le sala tupe i lalo o le parakalafa
(a).
- (2) E solitulafono le tagata e lē usitaia le poloaiga 2 ma le 3 ma o fa'asalaga nei:
- (a) mo tagata ta'ito'atasi o le sala tupe \$2000 ; ma
(e) mo faalapopotoga faatulafono po'o se kamupani o le sala tupe e \$15,000 mo le solitulafono muamua ma le \$20,000 i aso taitasi e faaauau ai lea solitulafono.
- (3) E solitulafono le tagata e lē usitaia tuutuuga mo le faanofoesea e faatonuina e le Faatonu Sili o le Matagaluega o Soifua Maloloina, ma e ono faasala i se sala tupe e \$2,000.00.
- (4) O le totogiina o se sala tupe atoa i lalo o lenei poloaiga, o le a lē molia ai se tagata i se faamasinoga o soligatulafono mo le faasalaga i lalo o le Pepa Faailoa o le Solia o se Poloaiga i lalo o le poloaiga 12.
- (5) A faamaonia le solitulafono a se tasi i lalo o nei poloaiga i luma o se faamasinoga o soligatulafono, e mafai ona faasala i se sala tupe e le sili atu i le \$10,000 poo le fale puipui e lē sili atu i le 12 masina, poo faasalaga uma e lua.
- (6) Mo so'o se pisinisi latou te solia Poloaiga 6 ma le 7 o lenei Poloaiga, o lea faaleaogaina laisene pisinisi poo laisene ava malosi faatasi ai ma faasalaga o loo i lalo o Tulafono o loo aiaia ai laisene pisinisi ma ava malosi.

14. Komiti Fautua - Mataupu 108:

O le Komiti Fautua ua faatuina i lalo o le Mataupu 108 o le Tulafono Faavae, e puipuia mai i ni tagi faaetulafono e ono tulai faasaga i le Komiti i le faatinoina o tiute fai i lalo o le tulafono.

15. Taulumaga:

(1) Mo le nofo sauniuni mo se tulaga ogaoga mai auga o lenei faamai Korona Vairasi-19, e mafai ona faataatia ese Tulafono o taualumaga a le Palemene ma le Kapeneta, ina ia mafai ai pea ona faia ni faaiuga tatau mo le atunuu.

(2) Mo le faia o poloaiga tatau, e mafai ona faia fonotaga faanatinati ma ni faaiuga o le Palemene poo le Kapeneta i lalo o malosiaga o le Tulafono Faavae.


16. Fuafuaga o Faalavelave Tutupu Faafuasei:

O nei poloaiga e aofia i totonu o Fuafuaga o Faalavelave Tutupu Faafuasei (National Disaster Management Plan) e pei ona aiaia i lalo o le Tulafono o le Faafoega o Faalavelave Matuia ma Faalavelave Faafuasei 2007.
