



**Note**: The cut off for daily reporting is 2pm, therefore numbers reporting after 2pm will be reflected in the next reporting periods' count.


Figure 2. Weekly total of community cases vs 7-day rolling average



# **III.** Laboratory Update

#### As of 2:00pm Local Time May 29, 2022

- Results of the COVID-19 samples sent overseas on May 15, 2022 for whole genome sequencing shows that BA1.1.9 is the SARS-CoV-2 variant currently circulating in Samoa.
- Total of 9,332 PCR GeneXpert cartridges for COVID-19 testing were in stock for processing within country.

# IV. Repatriation flights and quarantine update

#### As of <u>02:00pm Local Time May 29, 2022</u>

- A repatriation flight NZ990 from New Zealand arrived on May 29, 2022 with 191 passengers.
  - All passengers were swabbed on arrival and results are pending.
- A repatriation flight FJ225 from Fiji arrived on May 28, 2022 with 152 passengers.
  - All passengers were swabbed on arrival and returned 4 positive COVID-19 PCR test results.
- A repatriation flight QF333 from Australia arrived on May 24, 2022 with 176 passengers.
  - All passengers were swabbed on arrival and returned 7 positive COVID-19 PCR test results.
  - On Day 3 (May 27, 2022), there were no new positive cases from the self-reports received (table 7 below).

- A commercial flight NZ990 from New Zealand arrived on May 22, 2022 with 107 passengers.
  - All passengers were swabbed on arrival and returned one positive COVID-19 PCR test result.
  - On Day 3 (May 25, 2022), there were no new positive cases from the self-reports received (see table 8 below)
  - On Day 7 (May 29, 2022), there were no new positive cases from the self-reports received (see table 8 below)

  - All passengers were swabbed on arrival and returned 6 COVID-19 positive PCR test results.

  - On Day 7 (May 22, 2022), there was one new COVID-19 positive case reported (see table 9 below)

- A repatriation flight FJ255 from Fiji arrived on May 14, 2022 with 124 passengers.
  - All passengers were swabbed on arrival and returned 2 COVID-19 positive PCR test results.
  - On Day 3 (May 17, 2022), 91 of the passengers reported negative rapid antigen test results and 33 have not reported in their test results.
  - On Day 7 (May 21, 2022), 69 have reported negative rapid antigen test results and 55 have not reported their test results.
