

Note: The cut off for daily reporting is 2pm, therefore numbers reporting after 2pm will be reflected in the next reporting periods' count.





Figure 2. Weekly total of community cases vs 7-day rolling average



IV. Repatriation flights and quarantine update

As of 02:00pm Local Time June 19, 2022

- A repatriation flight QF333 from Australia on June 14, 2022 with 66 passengers. •
 - All passengers were swabbed on arrival and returned 1 positive COVID-19 test results.
 - On Day 5 (June 19, 2022), 5 reported negative and 61 have yet to report.
- A repatriation flight NZ990 from New Zealand on June 12, 2022 with 301 passengers. •
 - All passengers were swabbed on arrival and returned 3 positive COVID-19 PCR test results.
 - On Day 5 (June 17, 2022), there were no new positive cases from the self-reports received (table 5 below).
