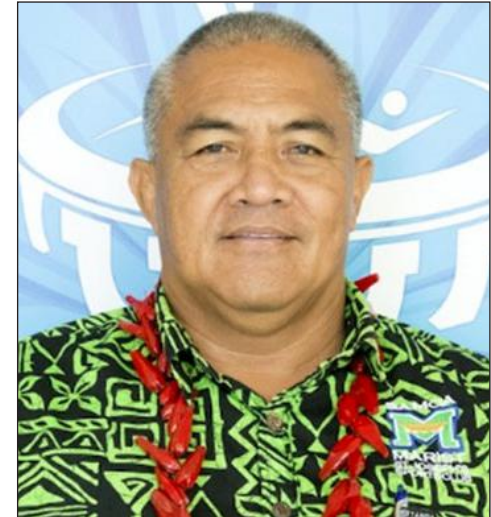

Ensuring a well Governed, Safe and Informed Samoa

PRESS RELEASE – GOVERNMENT COMMUNICATIONS LIAISON OFFICERS NETWORK FORUM 2023

(GOVT. PRESS SECRETARIAT) – Articulated in her Mission to "Ensure a well-governed, safe, and informed Samoa," the Ministry of the Prime Minister and Cabinet, (MPMC) this week Tuesday marched on with the 3rd annual Communication Information Liaison Officers Network (CLON) forum.

CLON was established three years ago and is designed to organize and strengthen the internal network responses by respective Communication Divisions and Officers in government to disseminate factual and timely information to stakeholders.

Since its formation, CLONs’ reach outside of the Government Sector has included independent media outlets, development partners, the private sector, the general public, etc. worldwide.

CLON is also part of the internal Communication Strategy Plan brainchild by the MPMC’s Press and Communication Division (Savali Newspaper and Government Press Secretariat) to strengthen the Government’s information sharing capacity for stakeholders to make informed decisions based on fact and not fiction.

Attended by more than 40 Government Communication Officers, MPMC’s Agafili Tomaimano Shem Leo in his launching remarks impressed on the value and importance of sharing factual and accurate government information with the masses.

"Sharing factual, informative, and accurate government information carries a lot of weight

and responsibility," Agafili stressed. "It reflects the accountability of not just ourselves as public servants, but most importantly carries the weight of Governments’ accountability to ensure our people that we are working for their benefit and in their best interest."

With the global informational networks under siege from the unregulated social media, government efforts via CLON, complemented by the recently launched internal Informed Samoa Policy, are in place to minimize the fables and distorted chatter condemning and criticizing government without proof littering the social media.

And for this week’s forum, its objectives include;

- To further strengthen the coordination and partnership between communication liaison officers and the Press and Communication Division in sharing the responsibilities to effectively disseminate factual government information in a timely manner.
- To review and revisit the outcomes from previous forums, including identifying and addressing weaknesses and raising issues, in order to strengthen and improve communication partnership networks across government.
- Preparation and coordination of information sharing and public responses.
- Strengthening networks between the government and independent media.

Society of Agricultural Professionals established

A society of agricultural professionals has been launched in Samoa to aid with technical advice to the sector and provide a platform for knowledge sharing, skill enhancement and develop professional career pathways.

The Society of Agricultural Professionals (SOAP) was officially unveiled on Tuesday afternoon at the Scientific Research Organisation of Samoa (SROS).

Patron of the society Tusani Iosefatu Reti told the media the society will now work on getting the members together and start to identify skills and trainings they can share to Government Ministries and organisations such as SROS, and the University of the South Pacific (USP).

The society can also provide traditional knowledge about agriculture when required and keen to work on identifying issues currently faced by farmers across the country.

“We [the society] are working together to try and find some solutions

needed for agriculture development in our country,” Tusani told the media.

Asked how many members they would welcome - as many as possible he said.

Agriculture and Fisheries Minister, Laauli Leuatea Polataivao Fosi on behalf of the Government said that Samoan Agriculture has come a long-way and is the back-bone of the economy.

“The changes in technology now days also comes with the changing of farming practices to many of our farmers,” he said.

As such the old methods have to be integrated with new innovation of farming practices in order to achieve sustainable farming objectives.

Laauli said the recent decline in agriculture contribution to the GDP of Samoa was due to many factors.

However, the increase in financial assistance to this very sector required that it was consulted on and utilised on technical agriculture so that funds could be internally and fairly circulated where necessary.

Vaa o Fonoti opens District Office

The Vaa-o-Fonoti District Office was officially opened on Saturday

Another Electoral Constituency has officially declared their District Office Open ready to serve the community and proceed with initiatives promised to build their communities and keep them self-sustaining – Vaa o Fonoti launched theirs last Saturday.

Rev Tapuni Malolo of the EFKS Taelefaga Fagaloa church cut the ribbon to officiate the event.

The office is located at the old Taelefaga Primary School location and three classrooms of that building were renovated and refitted to cater to the facilities required for a District Centre.

Member of Parliament Mauu Siao Si Puepuemai revealed the committee received the initial \$200,000 for establishing the district office last year in June.

The total cost for establishing the office was \$189,426 and include renovations, lease, cost of labour and allowances for the members of the committee which are all part of the specific guidelines under the use of the first initial funding to launch the first phase of developments before the distribution of funds under the \$1million District Development Grant initiative.

The MP also took the opportunity to share plans by the committee for sustainable and long-term district developments that will be funded by the grant.

He said his constituency's focus will be developing initiatives in agriculture noting the benefits of ava and koko as commodities with a lucrative market already established across the country and overseas that can generate good income.

Minister of Women, Community, and Social Development Leota Laki Lamositele commended the district for their hard work and drive to develop reflected in the opening of the office which denotes trust and faith in plans already laid out by the Government to profit the people.

The Minister said it was the Government's wish to join forces to achieve the best in all areas including the implementation of developments while districts continue to progress and the community reaps the benefits.

MAF addresses biosecurity risks

Samoa's Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries (MAF) continues its battle against pests contaminating sea containers.

This was the purpose behind a gathering recently hosted by MAF and Safe Agricultural Trade Facilitation through Economic Integration in the Pacific better known as SAFE Pacific to address biosecurity risks that can be combated with the Sea Container Hygiene System (SCHS).

The container hygiene system is a biosecurity programme developed to manage contamination and transport of hitchhiker pests via sea containers that continue to threaten Samoa's ecosystems and biodiversity.

Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of MAF Tilafono David Hunter

ensured the participants the implementation of the hygiene system will help ease biosecurity processes since sea containers at the port of export go through standard cleaning procedures.

He reiterated that all parties involved; exporters, pack-house operators, accredited SCHS cleaning facilities, forward freighters, shipping lines, stevedores and border agencies play an important role to ensure continual compliance to reduce biosecurity interventions.

However, Tilafono urged, "we need to do all we can to work with the SCHS to mitigate the challenges emerging from biosecurity risks to protect our food security, nutrition, and exports".

According to the Agriculture Chief the majority of the world's trading export and import activities estimated at 80-90% are transported via sea containers.

So, containers have always been in the limelight as a pathway through which contaminating pests sneak into countries borders.

And this is where the regional SCHS comes in, a joint initiative by the New Zealand Ministry of Primary Industries (NZMPI) and the Australia Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF) to aid Pacific Island Countries in the movement of clean and pest-free containers.

He named pests like the Coconut Rhinoceros beetle and the Giant African snail as some that continue to pose a serious threat to Samoa's food production and income security.

"Our best line of defense therefore is the protection of our borders from pest and disease intrusion, because admittedly, we don't have the capacity and resources to control and manage the spread of these pests and diseases once they are in our country."

SBS launches poverty reports

The Samoa Bureau of Statistics (SBS) has launched the Samoa Poverty/Hardship Report 2022 and the first ever Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) Report 2022.

An MPI is based on the access of individuals to areas such as health services, food and water, living standards.

Speaking on behalf of the Government, Minister of Women Community and Social Development (MWCS) Leota Laki Lamositele says that the reports are a significant milestone for SBS as it is an indication of its capability to provide such high-quality information that will help enhance the development of Samoa.

"Over the years, Samoa has been measuring poverty and hardship on monetary terms based on the results of the Household Income and Expenditure Survey, which is conducted every five years," Leota says.

"The Bureau has taken a further step by measuring poverty and hardship in non-monetary terms using the same survey hence the development of Samoa's first every MPI using international practice, the first in the Pacific region to do so."

Leota says that the SBS is currently conducting the 2023 HIES which is the beginning of another five-year cycle.

He explained that the Samoa Poverty and Hardship report is based on the Food Poverty Line (minimum daily nutrition requirements) and the Basic Needs Poverty Line (represents expenses related to basic needs such as housing, health, education, and utilities).

Leota explained that the Multi-Dimensional Poverty index on the other hand is based on the access of individuals to non-monetary measures of poverty such as access to health services, access to food and water, access to education.

"Poverty being a global issue has affected our country to a large extent based on the analysis of both reports," the Minister says.

He encourages everyone to use the report as it will help with the formulation of relevant policies and strategies targeting the vulnerable people in Samoa to ensure that no one is left behind.

He had then thanked those involved in the development of the reports which included the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).

The reports were launched on Thursday at the TATTE Conference Room and was attended by Minister of MWCS Leota Laki Lamositele Sio, Deputy UNDP Resident Representative Verena Linneweber, Government Statistician Leota Aliielua Salani, and representatives of Government Ministries.

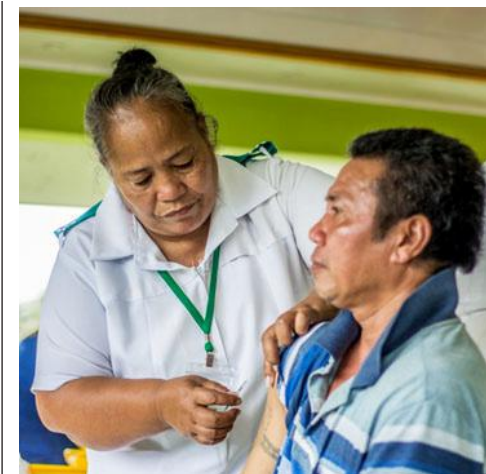

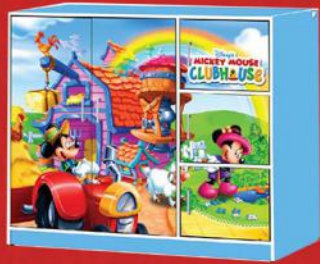
