Health Minister refutes Nurses unpaid overtime claims

The Minister of Health Valasi Tafito Selesele is calling out the President of the Samoa Nurses Association Solialofi Papali'i to provide documents to substantiate her allegations that nurses overtime claims for the last six months have not been paid.

Papali'i accusations was aired on TV 1 Samoa local news Wednesday

night.

And yesterday afternoon, the Minister in an exclusive interview with the Savali News refuted the claim pointing out that the Ministry of Health's Human Resources Division have assured him that all the nurses overtime have been paid.

"I find it amusing because the nursing fraternity including Papali'i have never informed officials and myself," said Tafito. "Shocked is an

National ID Project back in the limelight

After a 3 year hiatus, the Government's National Identification Card project is back on line with proposed legislations for the project to proceed scheduled to be tabled before Parliament in the coming weeks, Prime Minister Fiame Naomi Mataafa revealed during his latest Press Conference.


The National ID concept has been long in the government's thinking tank, but it was bottlenecked to allow ground work which included a national registration to be completed and used as a data base.

The legislation, according to the Prime Minister will address a range of issues and provide a framework guided by a standard operating procedure on how the ID will be processed and legally recognised locally and internationally.

"With the rapid evolution of modern technology coupled with the country's economic growth, and population growth, the timing is right," said Prime Minister Fiame.

It's speculated that the new ID would replace our voters ID and may be recognised as the Official Health or Medical ID.

Inter-island entry permits still in effect

Addressing the entry permits confusion between the two Samoas, provoked by unsubstantiated independent media reports, Prime Minister Fiame Naomi Mataafa sat the record straight during her recent press conference reaffirming that the current permit requirements for inter-island travel is still in effect.

And nothing has changed since the last round of talks in April between the 2 Samoas hosted by American Samoa.

Clarifying the issues, the Prime Minister acknowledged that the territorial Government after the talks had proposed a 7 day free entry

permit for local residents complemented with a US\$20 fee exempt the Police and Medical Reports.

This is contrary to Samoa's 14 day entry proposal for local residents to enter American Samoa without any fee or charges, added Fiame. And as an act of good faith, Government will reactivate the automatic 90 day entry for American Samoa nationals provided each traveler must have a return ticket. The \$10 tala permit fee for American Samoa nationals will also be removed.

"It's an ongoing issue and the conversations between officials from the two Samoas will hopefully come to a common ground of compromise," she concluded.

understatement to say the least."

Caught by surprise, Tafito is demanding a list of unpaid overtime claims with details including the names which will help officials verify if there are any unpaid overtime claims or not. "If there are claims, then they will be paid," he assured.

Papalii also voiced her concerns that if these

management problems are not resolved there will be a mass exit of nurses overseas for attractive severance for their services.

But the Minister countered saying that skilled and trained Samoan professionals seeking greener pastures overseas for their family security and future is an on-going challenge. "It is not a new issue and that is

the right of any individual including nurses to seek better paying jobs overseas," refuted the Minister. "A classical example, is the Seasonal Workers Program," added Tafito.

Before exiting the Minister issued a dare to the Samoa Nurses Association President to present a bullet proof strategy plan to prevent nurses from migrating overseas.



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

Head of State of Samoa attends the Coronation of King Charles III

PR - LONDON, UNITED KINGDOM, Saturday, 6th May 2023: The Head of State Afioga i le Ao Mamalu o le Malo, Tuimalealiifano Va'aleto'a Sualauvi II and, Masiofo Faamausili Leinafo Tuimalealiifano today joined more than 2000 participants comprising leaders and representatives from more than 200 countries at a ceremony held at Westminster Abbey officially crowning King Charles III and Queen Camilla.

The celebrations featured customs dating back more than 1,000 years. Several Pacific and Commonwealth leaders were also in London for the celebrations.

Afioga i le Ao Mamalu o le Malo and Masiofo were invited to The Kings reception for overseas representatives held at Buckingham Palace on the evening of 5th May 2023. Prior to the reception they were also invited to events organized by the Commonwealth Secretariat at Malborough House.

The Commonwealth event was for the Leaders to welcome the King as the new Head of the Commonwealth; and also to celebrate the Commonwealth and reflect on its future. Samoa's Head of State, the Prime Minister of the United Kingdom and the President of Rwanda joined the Commonwealth Secretary General to greet His Majesty when he came to meet with the Commonwealth Leaders.

The Government of the United Kingdom on the eve of the coronation organised a Breakfast Event for Small Island Developing States (SIDS) to mark their commitment to a successful 4th International Conference on Small Island Developing States in 2024.

The Duke and Duchess of Edinburgh attended the event along with SIDS leaders and representatives and international development partners. Samoa was represented by the Head of State who delivered a statement on behalf of AOSIS. He was followed by the UK Foreign Secretary, Rt Honourable James Cleverly who highlighted the UK setting out an ambitious vision for SIDS in their development strategy; with a focus on climate and economic resilience. "The UK is prioritising international finance reform to better address developing countries' need." he said.

The UK sees the 2024 UN SIDS Summit as an important opportunity to get priorities right for SIDS. Samoa had outlined these SIDS priorities during the AOSIS statement and the importance of partnerships to ensure "a more targeted, robust, measurable, and new sustainable development blueprint to be adopted at the Fourth United Nations Conference for SIDS (SIDS4) in the Summer of 2024 in Antigua and Barbuda."

Samoa's delegation to the coronation included H.E Francella Strickland, Samoa's Ambassador to the Kingdom of Belgium and High Commissioner to the United Kingdom; Ulugia Mareko Tulouna, Private Secretary to the Head of State, and Supt. Norman Tuafale Meni, Aide-de-Camp, Ministry of Police. The delegation also met with H.E Fatumanava Dr Paolelei Luteru Samoa's Ambassador to the US and Permanent Representative to the UN in New York, who was in London for AOSIS related meetings.

The delegation left London on Sunday 8th May to return to Samoa.

Overseas Medical Scheme, (OMS) under the microscope

(RNZ PACIFIC) - The Samoan government is worried about the increasing number of young people needing urgent overseas treatment for non-communicable diseases.

Prime Minister Fiame Mata'afa said Cabinet had approved 13 requests in one week this month for financial assistance under the government's Overseas Medical Scheme (OMS).

She said her government is worried about its affordability.

Fiame told local media Cabinet has asked the Minister of Health and his ministry to look at ways to reduce these costs.

"The Government allocates funding each financial year for this scheme but there seems to be an increase in the number of patients and the money allocated isn't enough for these requests," she said.

In March, the Government approved an additional \$5 million tālā for the continuation of the OMS for the remaining months of this fiscal year.

This is in addition to an increase to the scheme of \$6 million tālā in November last year.

Fiamē added that there is an offer from a medical institution

in Fiji to take patients from Samoa at a much cheaper cost.

However, she added that there are also programmes - in partnerships with other countries - that bring in medical experts to do the operations and offer specialist treatment in the country.

"We can only advise all of us to look at changing lifestyles including dietary changes and find alternatives if we are to see a downward trajectory in the prevalence of NCDs in Samoa and move towards a healthier pathway, particularly for our youth," she said.

American Samoa wants Pacific Islands Forum upgrade

(RNZ PACIFIC) - American Samoa wants more involvement at the Pacific Islands Forum (PIF).

It wants associate member status after being a Forum observer since 2011.

Other PIF observer countries and territories include the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas, Guam, Timor Leste, and Wallis and Futuna.

Discussions were held on May 3 involving the Governor Lemanu Mauga and the US State Department on how the territory could have more sway at the regional level.

The PIF is the region's premiere political organisation with 18 countries and territories as members.

A statement from Governor Lemanu's following the meeting with the US Deputy Secretary of State Wendy Sherman said it was crucial for American Samoa to push for greater inclusion in this agency.

It said having a seat at the Forum would allow American Samoa to participate in important policy discussions and decision-making processes that directly impact the territory.

The State Department was informed that as one of the US territories in the Pacific,

American Samoa has often been hindered by bureaucratic issues and limited regional cooperation with its neighbouring island states.

Over the years, American Samoa's isolation from regional decision-making has contributed to a lack of adequate representation and support on relevant issues including climate change, public health, and economic development.

"Having a seat at the Pacific Islands Forum would allow American Samoa to participate in important policy discussions and decision-making processes that directly impact the territory's future in the Pacific," the according to the statement from the Governor's office.

"If granted the opportunity to become a PIF Associate member, American Samoa can make a valuable contribution to the region as a whole. Through active participation, American Samoa will be able to share its unique perspectives and experiences on various issues," the statement concluded.

No information is available yet as to when the State Department plans to act on American Samoa's request.

RNZ Pacific has also contacted the Forum for comment.

Deputy Prime Minister Tuala Tevaga Iosefo Ponifasio had the honour of raising the nation's flag as part of the program.


And on the opposite field from the District Office, farmers organised an exhibition showcasing various crops to the public and it was also a

Moataa has done it again – proved the commitment and dedication they have to ensuring their community and constituency of Vaimauga #2 benefits from Government's \$1million District Development Grant.

How have they done that – by ensuring that the sewing tools and equipment provided to them in March bear's fruit.

And on Wednesday morning the Women's Committee took to the streets of Moataa in a parade to showcase proudly the outcome of their work.

Months later since they started their sewing programme and they have much to tell: woven mats with their own unique designs sewn onto it and dresses.

The project from Government has been questioned by people on its deliverance, but leader of the Moataa Women's Committee, Samalaulu Keri Liaga Lino was all praises about the project.

According to Samalaulu the funding has enabled them to hone their creative seamstress and designer skills passed on to



all women of the village, for a productive outcome.

These very items were also put up for sale by the committee gaining them the opportunity to generate more funds from their initiatives.

Half of the money goes to the women who produced the items and the other half goes towards funding materials so that their initiative can continue said Samalaulu.

She was ecstatic that most of the women in the village now know how to sew, as part of the initiative was hosting sewing classes.

"There are now youth that like to use the sewing machines," she happily said.

Samalaulu also revealed that other villages have also shown interest in joining their

sewing classes. This has prompted an idea to share to other villages within the constituency of Vaimauga #2 the art of sewing and mat weaving with designs threaded on.

But for the time being they will work on a plan how to cater the classes for residents from neighbouring villages to learn for a minimum fee.

"I thank the Government for the \$1 million, because without it this would not be possible," she says.

The showcase of the initiative was attended by Vaimauga 2 Member of Parliament Lenata'i Victor Tamapua and the Women's Committee of Moataa.


