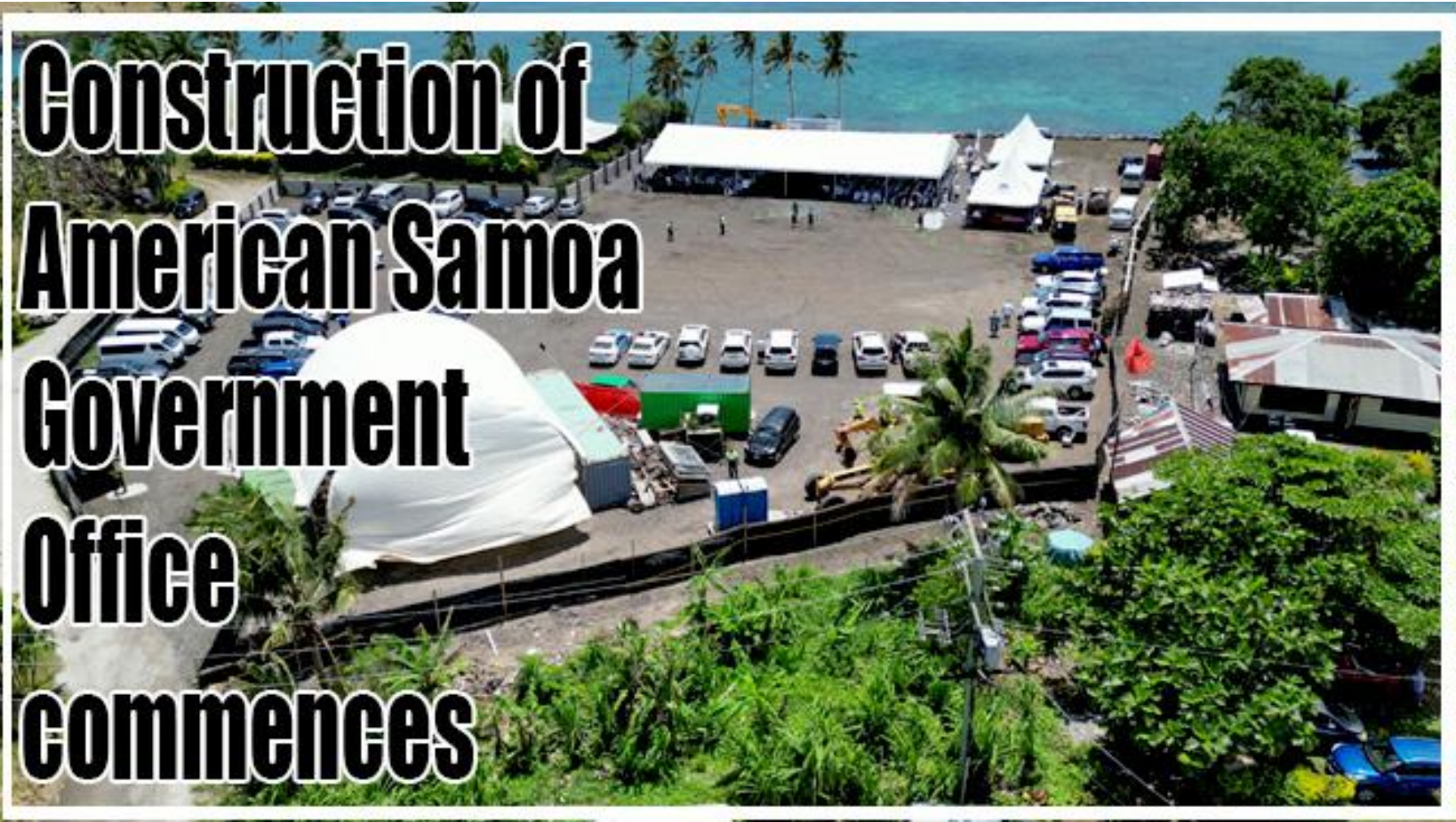

Work on building the American Samoa Government office will soon be underway following the ground-breaking ceremony by the two Governments on Tuesday morning.

The site where the office will be built is at Moataa behind the village's Primary school building and across from the Taumeasina Island Resort.

The land is an outcome of the past Atoa o Samoa Executive meetings.

It was blessed in a service led by President of the Methodist Church in Samoa Rev. Faulalo Leti Paaga.

Speaking on behalf of the Government of Samoa, Prime Minister Fiame Naomi Mataafa says that despite American Samoa and Samoa being two separate Governments, it does not remove the connection founded by ancestors who have passed on.

"Samoa is a family," Fiame says.

Speaking of the 4th Atoa o Samoa meeting that Samoa is hosting, she believes it has a huge contribution in guiding them into the future especially in responding to challenges affecting the small island nations.

She thanked the American Samoa Government for the land given to them in Tafuna that will be the location of the Government of Samoa's office.

4th Atoa o Samoa Executive Meeting underway

Samoa has welcomed American Samoa delegates of the 4th Atoa o Samoa meeting currently underway on our shores.

The meeting kicked off on Wednesday at the Taumeasina Island Resort and was officially opened by Samoa's Prime Minister Fiame Naomi Mataafa and Governor of American Samoa Lemanu Palepoi Sialegā Mauga.

The Atoa o Samoa meeting is an opportunity for the two Samoas to strengthen cooperation in areas of mutual interest.

The meeting agenda raised discussions on various topics including; immigration, environment, climate change, and health to name a few. Speaking during the opening ceremony, Fiame said that the meeting will have meaningful discussions on efforts made since the commencement of the first meeting.

The first meeting happened in 2022 in American Samoa with the second session hosted here in Apia in October that year.

It was agreed during that time that both countries will take turns hosting the executive meetings - American Samoa in April and Samoa in October on an annual basis.

"May God be with us in our meeting today, and in preparations and conclusion of the programme in Savaii tomorrow (Thursday)," she says.

Lemanu in his keynote address during the opening ceremony gave his thanks to the Government of Samoa for the piece of land at Moataa where the American Samoa Government office in Apia will be constructed and located.

The 4th Atoa o Samoa meeting will conclude in Savaii after site visits to various infrastructure, agriculture, and social projects in the big island.

Lalomalava Primary School soon to have new school building

Soon the 200 or so students and 8 staff of the Lalomalava Primary School in Savaii will have a safer environment to carry out their lessons.

Thanks to the Government of Japan's Grant Assistance For Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP), through the Embassy of Japan in Apia.

A grant of \$582,000 (USD\$215,301) was officially signed over to the school committee of the primary school to execute construction of a new school building with 8 classrooms, a library, principal room, staff room, reception, and toilets.

The financial agreement was signed yesterday (Thursday) between Japan's Ambassador to Samoa, H.E. Senta Keisuke and President of the school committee, Tumanuvao Ross, in the presence of the local media and members of the committee.

Ambassador Senta told the group that he looked forward to seeing them all again to witness the official handover of the project and wished them well in their endeavours for the construction of the new school building.

According to the school committee Treasurer Rev. Sotiaka Roma the new building will replace the old deteriorating structure that was recorded to have been built sometime in 1986.

The classrooms although very spacious and catered well for the capacity of students, he said the issue was that it was no longer safe

for the students to receive and for teachers to give out their lessons.

So once the construction work is completed and the new building erected it will provide a safer and improved environment for students and teachers.

When the project will roll out says Rev. Roma will depend on their meeting with the Construction Company and engineer.

He said that part of the agreement under the GGP requires that the project is completed within 12 months from the day the contract is signed.

As a result it is likely that construction work will start next year in January and if all goes all by this time next year the school building is ready for use.

The Rev. expressed appreciation and thankfulness to the ambassador and the Government of Japan for this assistance.

According to him without this financial grant the school would not be able to afford to erect a new school building.

Fagalii Pilot's Biolog Filter Project

The High Chief of Fagalii Tuisugaletaua Sofara Aveau is praising the newest environmental filtration method to reach our shores – the Biolog Filter.

The Biolog filter is an environmentally friendly filtration system made from biodegradable materials 100% coconut coir fibres that filters turbid water discharged from civil engineering works and river banks.

MNRE's A.C.E.O. of the Water Resources Division, Asuao Malaki Iakopo told Savali the filter will help keep the rivers in the area clean by absorbing soil materials that might pollute ecosystems, and damage the quality of water that runs off into the ocean, damaging coral reefs and endangering marine species.

Most of the village's food source and income is the marine species from the sea says Asuao, and this filtration system that is created by natural coconut fibres will help solve the village's soil erosion problems.

He said soil erosion was identified some time ago as a major problem for the village of Fagalii. So, when the opportunity of this natural filtration method was showcased by the Okinawa Prefecture a few years ago, it was the perfect project to be utilised for Fagalii.

On Wednesday afternoon the program was officially launched at the Maota o le Pilioua at Fagalii.

According to Asuao the filter is manufactured by forming coconut fibres into a cylinder shape and wrapping the cylinder with nets from the coconut husk.

Inside is a pipe that is the filter and can be cleaned on a monthly basis. The biolog filters however will biodegrade in 5 to 8 years' time.

The biologs are placed at Fagalii, Fagalii tai and at the Ford at Fagalii-uta.

Fagalii is the piloting candidate for the program made possible under the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment's Water

Resources Division in collaboration with JICA, a team from Okinawa Prefecture, and Bluebird Construction.

The Ministry is also working on erecting signages in the Samoan language to ensure that members of the community are aware of the importance of these contraptions to the environment so that they will not be damaged in any way especially by smokers says the A.C.E.O.

The devices are easy to create and the Ministry and all partners involved are working on a business case so that the construction of these devices can be executed here in Samoa and be easily accessed by other interested villages and businesses and organisations for the same purpose of improving quality of water, and protection of plant and marine and clear water species.

Local women graduate from Training course on creative handicrafts and sewing technology

Close to 90 young girls and women from across Upolu and Savaii are now expert seamstresses thanks to a 7 week program equipping them with life skills economically empowering them to run their own business.

The course was sponsored by the People's Republic of China's Ministry of Commerce, and organised by the Hunan International Business Vocational College.

Last Friday at Tooa Salamasina Hall they received their certificates in a graduation ceremony attended by members of Cabinet, Chinese representatives in Samoa, family, friends and staff of the Ministry of Women, Community and Social Development (M.W.C.S.D.).

The Training course on Creative Handicraft and Sewing Technology for Samoa 2023 started on 21 August and was completed on 05 October a day before the ceremony.

At least each participant was nominated by their respective District council to participate and are now armed with not only sewing skills but sewing machine repair knowledge.

Mulipola Anarosa Ale Molio'o, Minister of Women, Community and Social Development, in her keynote address reiterated that equipping the individuals with these like skills will help them start up their own small businesses to support their families and communities.

Adding that the training is part of the Government's efforts to realise Samoa's national priorities set out in the pathway for the Development of Samoa (PDS 2021-2026).

These are; improving social development, alleviating poverty, people's empowerment, as well as community development.

Participants went home after the graduation with their sewing machines and tools to initiate the start-up of their businesses.

According to the Minister this is to sustain the skill and knowledge and ensure continuity of the programme.

She told the audience prior to formalities she had the opportunity to view items sewn by participants, and she was very impressed with the progress.

Thus acknowledging the People's Republic of China and the Hunan International Business Vocational College and the Trainers and translators for their time and dedication which enabled this training to go ahead and

be completed successfully.

"Without a doubt this training was an opportunity to develop professionals and personal network relationship and friendship amongst participants, trainers and translator and ministry staff."

Chinese Ambassador to Samoa Chao Xiaoliang expressed his sincerest gratitude to the Ministry of Women, Community and Social Development of Samoa for their cooperation and support which allowed the success of the program.

He extended thanks to the Hunan International Business Vocational College for their professional knowledge and dedication before giving his warm congratulations to all Chinese who invested a lot of time and energy to participate in the training course.

Addressing the participants the ambassador said he believes each one of them will utilise their new found knowledge, and create a better life for themselves into the future.

He said the training involved 84 participants who were trained on design and production skills, ranging from children to adult wear, and Causal to locally specialised designs.

The training produced 1000 piece of children's wear, 300 pieces for adult, and 60

pieces of local designs.

But iterated Minister Mulipola's comments that one of the most important aspects of this training is that it brings people together and strengthens relationships.

2300 Samoans have received training in a wide range of areas said the ambassador including human resource, agriculture, public health, transport and infrastructure and international trade.

Prime Minister opens Sunshine Pacific's Afolau chicken processing factory at Mulifanua

Prime Minister Fiame Naomi Mataafa has called the opening of Sunshine Pacific's Afolau Chicken Processing Factory at Mulifanua, a solution to limited sustainable food supply in Samoa during natural disasters and pandemics.

A platform that will aid in job opportunities and reduce Samoa's dependency on imported goods especially chicken.

The Prime Minister was speaking at the opening of the factory last Friday, where she told the audience that this was a challenge realised during the global pandemic Covid-19.

During the pandemic Samoa was taught many lessons that made way for the creation of "new platforms and possibilities for the development of Samoa".

"One of these important lessons was, we could not continue to depend on imported goods, meat and vegetables," she said.

Adding that the pandemic was a good reminder that it is crucial to start looking inward and explore advanced sustainable measures for food security.

The new business venture; a subsidiary of Frankie's, is an initiative that resulted from taking sustainable measures to alleviate shortage of food supplies said Fiame.

The factory will certainly enhance food security in Samoa, sustain resilience and provide alternatives to imported meat says the Prime Minister.

And if all goes well, the Prime Minister strongly believes, this project will consolidate and support the trade and manufacture sectors.

The Sunshine Pacific Ltd in expanding its vision for agricultural production into poultry farming, says Fiame and will work closely with the nearby district councils.

This is not only to provide employment opportunities, but also in supporting local poultry farmers and farming.

In the pipeline is for the factory to produce and export Samoa locally processed chicken, to

neighbouring Pacific Island countries like; Fiji, Tonga, the Cook Islands and other countries in the world.

JOB OPPORTUNITIES

With the establishment of job opportunities in the opening of the Sunshine Pacific Afolau Chicken Factory, the Prime Minister says young people will not need to travel overseas for employment.

And, this will sustain the skills and knowledge to aid in Samoa's development.

"This chicken processing plant, the vegetable farms and poultry and eggs businesses operated by Sunshine Pacific Ltd, will without a doubt provide substantial and considerable assistance to food security during Samoa's hosting of the 2024 CHOGM and similar conferences and meetings in the future."

Also noting her belief that the project will continue to support Government's drive to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals 2030, especially on alleviating poverty, creating decent work and achieving zero hunger.

The Prime Minister then challenged all the local businesses and development stakeholders and partners, "to delve into advanced, pioneering and sustainable development initiatives, and explore possibilities of establishing similar initiatives of large scale projects, with relevant outcomes for our people and the development of Samoa".

"Our Government will continue to provide the enabling environment and platforms for civil society and private business growth and development – ensuring sustainable livelihoods for all our people."

She expressed a big "faafetai tele and faamalo" to Frankie Group and the Sunshine Pacific Ltd for taking the lead in this development which is a contribution to Samoa's quest to strengthen innovativeness, become self-sufficient and resilient.

"May God bless this Project, endure and uphold its vision for the provision of safe, secured and healthy food sources for Samoa."

Avele College receives financial boost from Japan

Good news for students of Avele College today and the future.

The school has received financial assistance of \$601,000 for the reconstruction of a hall with a stage, kitchen and toilets.

The funds come from Japan's Grants Assistance For Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (GGP).

The financial agreement for the grant was officially signed yesterday (Thursday) morning between the President of the School Committee, and also a Member of Parliament Hon. Tagaloatele Pasi Poloa and Ambassador of Japan to Samoa, his Excellency Senta Keisuke.

Tagaloatele thanked the Ambassador and the Government of Japan for making this dream a reality.

And that he looked forward to seeing the project go up either with construction starting sometime before the end of this year or early next year.

He thanked the ambassador and acknowledged the opportunity provided to the college to make this long dream come true.

According to the President this will be the first time the college will have a fully functioning hall

to cater to needs of the college students and staff of Avele.

Although there was a building set up many years ago and utilised during the time when the college permitted students to board at the school, it eventually became too small.

Recently some two years ago the college demolished a smaller building that was set up later on for the purpose of housing students when necessary for their activities.

It is this location where the new hall is planned to be erected. At present the college utilises the Old Boys Hall but according to Tagaloatele this is further away from the school's location and the college needs their own to cater to their own needs.

Principal of the college and Secretary of the School Committee Tuala Soalo Otila Soalo, told the media at the signing ceremony the school currently has a roll of close to 700 students and a staff of 60.

The planned hall will specifically be the space for carrying out the prizegivings for the students he said.

It is like he said that this year's prizegiving will be the last to take place at the Old Boys Hall also on the grounds of the college but further away from the school premises.

Nicole Menzenbach is the new Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Federal Republic of Germany to Samoa.

Mrs. Menzenbach presented her Letter of Credence to the Member of the Council of Deputies Le Mamea Ropati Mualia on Thursday last week.

Afioga Le Mamea expressed his confidence that Mrs Nicole Menzenbach's appointment as Ambassador of Germany to Samoa will no doubt provide more opportunities for greater collaboration on matters of mutual interest to further strengthen Samoa and Germany's bilateral ties.

The new Ambassador was also welcomed by Prime Minister Fiame Naomi Mataafa in a reception held at the Roko's restaurant at Malifa.

Mrs. Menzenbach undertook Studies of Economics and Business Administration at the Albertus-Magnus University, Cologne and attained a PhD Fellow at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration, Technical University, Chemnitz.

She was the Advisor to Member of Parliament at the Parliament of the Federal Republic of Germany and then later as Senior Advisor to

the Minister of Foreign Affairs holding other senior positions within the Federal Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Mrs Menzenbach was posted as Minister Counsellor, Deputy Head of Mission in Lisbon Portugal, then later as Director of the German Information Centre South Asia in New Delhi, India. She posted as the Consul General of Germany to the New England States.

This is Mrs. Menzenbach's first Ambassadorial appointment to Wellington, New Zealand with cross accreditation to Samoa.

Samoa's long standing ties with Germany dates back to the 1900s while diplomatic relations were established in May 1972.

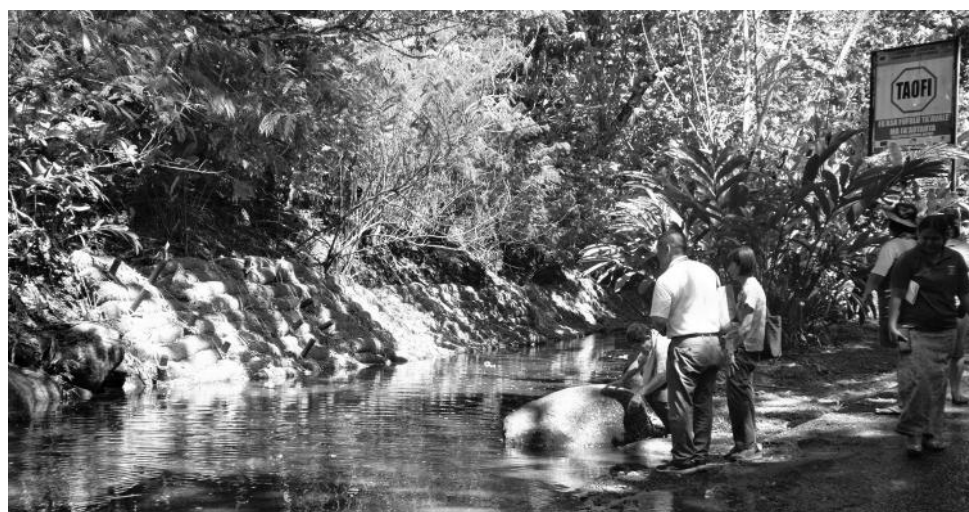
